GUIDELINES

2. Contestants must have shown a dairy project the past two years, including the current year.
3. Contestants will be judged on the basis of personality and poise, ability to express self orally, knowledge of their projects, church, school, 4-H, FFA or other activities.
4. If selected, must attend Jr. Fair activities for dairy. Must be neat in appearance and dress appropriately when attending any activities or promotional activities during the fair.
