Lamb Queen Guidelines

Following are the responsibilities of the Lamb and Wool Queen:

1. The Fayette County Lamb Queen and Wool Queen will assist with presentation of trophies and ribbons at the 2021 Fayette County Fair and assist with other sheep activities throughout the year.
2. The Lamb and Wool Queen will be given the opportunity to represent Fayette County and assist with ribbons and awards at the Ohio State Fair sheep show.

Following are the rules of eligibility:

1. The contestant must live on a farm where sheep are produced or her parents must derive part of their income from the production of lamb or the applicant must have a lamb project in 4-H or FFA.
2. Contestants will be judged on the basis of personality and poise, the content of an essay and her participation in community and school activities.
3. Each contestant must submit a 500-700 word written essay on any subject pertaining to lamb which may include marketing, production, or the consumption of lamb. This essay will not have to be memorized but judges may derive questions from the essay during the interview process.
4. Contestants must be age 14 to 19 inclusive.
