- 9. After judging, only a portion of the baked goods will be put on display. The remainder must be picked up after the judging.
- 10. Only one article per class for each exhibitor.
- 11. We reserve the right to use your recipe(s) in future publications.
- 12. Judging will be open to the public and will be at 3:00 PM on Saturday, July 13 in the Fine Arts Building.
