1. A season ticket or membership ticket is required to enter. Either ticket allows the holder to enter ANY OPEN CLASS at the fair and also allows the holder to enter the fair gate free every day of the fair. It does not allow the holder to ride the rides.
2. Entries must be made on Friday, **June 27** and Saturday, **June 28** from 9 AM-3 PM.
3. Deadline for entries are Saturday, **June 28** at 3 PM. No entries will be accepted or changed after this date. **Unless specifically stated, only one article per class for each exhibitor.**
4. Only entries in classes printed in this fair book will be accepted. Entry forms are available from the Senior Fair Office.
5. ALL exhibits must remain on display until **3 PM** on Saturday, **July 19** or premium will be forfeited. The fair board will not be responsible for anything left after 7 PM Saturday, **July 19**.
6. **In classes where no competition exists or if the opinion of the judges a first premium is not merited, the judges may award a lesser premium, no premium, or no Best of Show.**
7. Only one money will be paid per placing.
8. Entry tags are to be firmly attached to article by exhibitor.
9. Decision regarding acceptance of an entry will be at the discretion of the Superintendent or Director.
10. All Judge decisions are final.
11. The Fair board will not be responsible for any loss or damage due to any cause, whatsoever, but will exercise caution in protecting exhibits.
12. All premiums will be available for pickup on Saturday, **July 19, 2025** at 4 PM. Premiums not picked up by that date and time will be mailed to the exhibitor.
13. Superintendents/Exhibitors shall not move exhibits of other exhibitors once they are in place without the permission of the director and the exhibitor.

2. Entries must be made **June 27-28**.

3. Open to any individual.

4. Goods must be homemade, no ready mix unless otherwise noted and must be prepared by the exhibitor. No items requiring refrigeration will be accepted, however, cakes with cream cheese icing are permissible.

5. All articles entered in this department must be delivered to the Superintendent in the Fine Arts building between 1:00-2:30 PM on Saturday, **July 12**.

6. Breads must be removed from pans.
7. Canned and/or processed foods in Section VII VIII, IX, X and XI will not be tasted by the judge.
8. Prettiest ornamental cake, most artistic cupcakes, and most artistic pie will not be tasted by the judge and must remain at the fair the entire week. These will be judged on originality and appearance, not on taste.
9. After judging, only a portion of the baked goods will be put on display. The remainder must be picked up after the judging.
10. Only one article per class for each exhibitor.
11. We reserve the right to use your recipe(s) in future publications.
12. Judging will be open to the public and will be at 3:00 PM on Saturday, July 12 in the Fine Arts Building.
